NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

on October 21 5, 1935 12-1/2" 50 lb. casing was { Cemented } in Red Beds
formation at a depth of 260 feet on October 2, 19 35
150 sacks of El Toro Regular cement were used.

with pressure.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 260 feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
