T.D. 3805'. 10 3/4" csg. cemented at 325 with 150 sax.
 8 5/8" csg. set at 730. 7" csg. set at 1132. To plug and temporarily abandon. Pull 8 5/8" and 7". Fill with mud to 3600'. Set bridging plug and dump 10 sax cement. Same procedure for plugs at 2550, 1330, 15 sack plug at 760, 10 sax at 325. Regulation marker at surface. Cellar and pits to be levelled.
