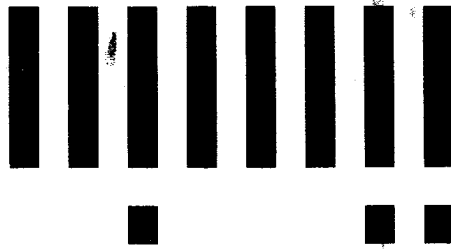

Gentlemen:

W. K. Byrom respectfully request that the Oil Conservation Commission grant an exception to No-Flare Order R-553 insofar as it pertains to W. K. Byrom's Flora Davis Well No. 1 and in support thereof furnishes the following facts:

The Flora Davis Well No. 1 is located 1650 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the East line of Section 8-T23S-R37E, Lea County, New Mexico. This well was completed August 20, 1956, in the Langlie-Mattix Pool and it initially produced at the rate of 58 barrels of oil per day with a gas-oil ratio of 4200 cubic feet per barrel. An oil allowable of 39 barrels per calendar day was assigned to the well.

Gulf Oil Corporation laid their own gas line under rail road track and highway and tied into Skelly Oil Company low pressure system. Skelly Oil Company, verbally, refused connection to their low pressure gathering system. They have refused to give us a connection because of the expense involved for such a small amount of gas. We will closely watch the potential market outlets and continue our efforts to obtain a market for the gas being flared.

In view of the foregoing and to keep the wells on production and thereby protect correlative rights, it is requested that the Oil Conservation Commission issue an exception to its No-Flare Order No. R-553 with respect to a casinghead gas volume of 168 MCF per day from Flora Davis Well No. 1 which will be vented pending receipt of a connection.
