DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well shot with 150 quats SNG from 3585' to 3533' and blank anchor used from 3585' to 3600' TD. AG Double Time Bomb used and shot tamped with 1-3/4 yds gravel. Shot exploded on time and hole failed to clean itself. From December 29th to Jan. 5th spent cleaning out hole after shot. 2" tubing set at 3596'. From Jan. 5th to January 17th waiting on pipe line connections and well was shut in for tank room. Pipe line company was late in making connections on this well because their gathering system had to be lowered. January 18th well was opened for 20 hours thru 18/64 choke with CP- 400 and TP-100 and flowed 172 bbls of pipe line oil.
