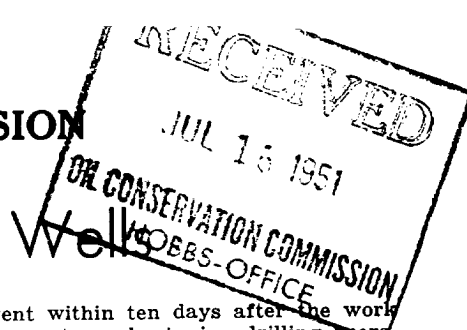

Drilled 265 ft. - Set 252 ft. of 10-3/4" casing with 150 sacks of Cement.
Drilled 3561 ft. (from derrick floor) - run 113 jts. 7" 20# J Seamless Casing (3549.26')
Obtained permission to set side shoe. This was not done because of plans to complete
Well with cable tools. Information obtained after original plans to set side shoe
made this seem impractical while working with cable tools.
Will perforate and cement at a later date.
Presently waiting on cable tools.
