DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5062' Plugged back depth, Plugged back with 7 sax Ottawa Sand and 8 gallons of Plastic and plugged back to 5022', Ran Halliburton drill stem test and recovered 745' of sulphur water, and gun perforated 5 1/2" Casing with 24 shots from 5014 to 5022' and set Baker Cement retainer and squeezed with 100 Sax Starcor cement with 2 sax lime ahead and with 2500# Pressure. Drilled out cement to 5022' and ran Halliburton drill stem test with packer set at 4984' and recovered 200' sulphur water. Plugged back to 5013' with 9 gallons of plastic to 5013' and drilled out plastic to 5037' and another Halliburton drill stem test with packer set at 4984' and recovered 340' of sulphur water.

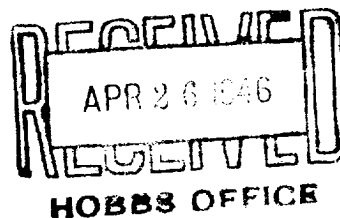

5037' Plugged back depth, drilled out sand and plastic to 5061' and ran Halliburton drill stem test with packer set at 4971' and recovered 4400' of sulphur water, Set Baker Cement retainer at 4961' and squeezed with 76 Sax Inferno Cement put up 4000# Pressure, drilled out cement, junk and plastic to 5076' and gun perforated with Lane Wells with 47 shots from 5057' to 5065' and ran Halliburton Drill Stem Test with Packer set at 4996' and recovered 900' of sulphur ~~water~~ water and preparing to drill deeper.
