DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5105' Plugged Back Depth, Set Baker Cement Retainer at 5077' and squeezed with 25 Sax Incon cement, laid down 2 1/2" EUE Tubing and picked up 2" EUE Tubing with American Hookwall packer set at 5049' and swabbed 7.63 barrels oil and 50.39 barrels of sulphur water in 13 hours. Pulled out 2" EUE Tubing and took off packer and put on Common working barrel and Tubing set at 5067' and swabbed 10.35 barrels of oil and 64.86 barrels of sulphur water in 24 hours. Set Pumping Unit and pumped 66.24 barrels oil and 44.16 barrels sulphur water in 24 hours pumping 18-40" strokes per minute on April 17, 1946.
