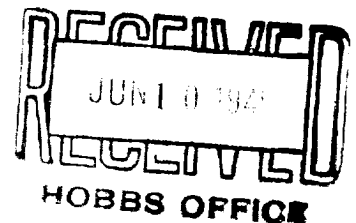

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5105' P.B.D. Shot off 5 1/2" Csg. at 2000', Pulled 66 joints 5 1/2" OD. Csg. 1982.60' and plugged 5 1/2" Csg. from 5000' to 4840' w/20 sacks cement & from 2500' to 2380' w/15 sacks cement, shot off 7-5/8" Csg. at 1970', Pulled 45 joints 7-5/8" OD. 1939.10'. Shot off 10-3/4" Casing at 200' & pulled 1 joint 10-3/4" OD. Casing 27'2". Plugged 10-3/4" Casing from 1050' to 970' w/20 sacks cement & from 40' to Surface with 20 sacks cement, Placed 1 piece of 4" Line pipe 5' above ground in center of surface plug. Well Plugged and abandoned. Finished at 2:00 P.M. June 7, 1949.
