November 1, 1945, went in hole with tubing and found top of cement at 5004' and drilled out cement to 5066' and tested casing with 1000 Pounds for 30 minutes and was OK, displaced mud with clear water and will gun perforate from 5058 to 5065' with 7 shots per foot.
