Gentlemen:

In a letter dated April 5, 1956, Mr. R. F. Montgomery, Geologist, notified The Texas Company that its State of New Mexico "BZ" NCT-8 Well No. 1, Section 16, Township 23, Range 37, Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, would have its allowable cancelled as of June 22, 1956, due to flaring of casinghead gas. By this letter, The Texas Company makes application for a NO FLARE ORDER for this well. The subject well is located at position "E", SW/4 NW/4, Section 16, on our State of New Mexico "BZ" Lease which consists of 480 acres comprising NW/4 and E/2 of Section 16, T-23-S, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The present gas production amounts to only 6 to 8 MCF per day, of which from 5 to 7 MCF per day is used for fuel, leaving only 1 MCF per day to be flared. The gas-oil ratio for this 20 BOPD well is approximately 400 cubic feet per barrel.

Skelly Oil Company has been contacted and is anxious to take gas from this lease for processing in their gasoline plant when additional development provides a sufficient volume of gas to market. However, in view of the small amount available at this time, they feel it is not economical to connect to this well.

Attached is a plat showing the well location, tank battery location, offset ownership, and the location of Skelly's low pressure gas line.
