DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This test was drilled as a dry hole to depth of 3710'. We therefore abandoned it by the following method. We filled the hole from 3710' to 2600' with heavy mud then set a cement plug of 5 sacks. We were able to recover 2499' of 7" casing. We then filled the hole with heavy mud to a depth of 1200' ~~with heavy mud~~ and set a cement plug of 5 sacks. The ~~9-5/8"~~ had previously been cemented to surface and none of it was, therefore, pulled. Hole was filled to surface and 4" marker set in top.
