## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This test has been carried to a depth of 3710' and at such depth has been tested and found dry. We therefore propose to abandon it by filling the hole from 3710' to 2600' with heavy mud then setting a 5 sack cement plug at this depth to isolate the salt from the underlying formation. Base of salt was encountered at 2570'. We will then fill the hole from the cement plug to 1200' with heavy mud and set another 5 sack cement plug. The hole will then be filled to surface with heavy mud and a 4" marker set in top, and extending six feet above ground, to mark the location.

Seven inch casing has been cemented at 3465' with 250 sacks and as much of this casing as can be pulled will be removed before plugging operations are commenced. The 9-5/8" casing was cemented at 694' with 250 sacks and it is doubtful that any of this can be pulled.
