A 12 1/2" hole was drilled to depth of 700' and 36# 9-5/8" National casing was cemented at 694' with 250 sacks. Total amount of 9-5/8" casing in hole is 684'. Plug was pumped down at 3 A.M. January 28, 1946.

Cement will be allowed a minimum setting time of 48 hours before casing is tested and plug is drilled.
