Dear Mr. Hunter:

This letter constitutes an application for authorization to drill complete an oil - gas well as follows:

1. Becker & Sheldon operates a well located 1500' from the south and 660' from the west line of Section 28-4330-437N, Lea County, New Mexico.

2. The well above described is known as the Stecker #1. It was completed at a depth of 1400' as an oil well producing from the lower Queen sand and is proved as being in the Langia-Martin oil field.

3. It is proposed to perforate the section between 3000' and 3100', to fracture the formation, and to produce gas through the casing-tubing annulus. The dual completion would be accomplished by setting a Halliburton type CL production pack at approximately 3100'.

4. The section from 3000' to 3100' is part of the Yates formation and being located in the NE 1/4 of Section 28-4330-437N will be in the Joint gas pool.

5. The acreage dedicated to the gas well will be the NE 1/4 of Section 28-4330-437N.

6. A plat of the area showing the location, acreage dedicated, and the offset properties is attached hereto.
