Drilled hole to 9685' and thoroughly tested McKee section of Simpson formation which was found to be unproductive. It is planned to spot 50 sacks of cement at 9577' and below and then run 7" OD casing to 3855', instead of 9600', and perforate casing with six 1/2" holes per foot in order to test the Grayburg formation.

If the Grayburg section from 3675' to 3765' is found unproductive, then propose to plug off this section and reperforate with 4 shots per foot in the Knight-Penrose section from 3375' to 3550' and 3265' to 3300'.
