Total tallies 2884', H-16, set @ 2900'. Cemented by Halliburton with 1200 sacks Reg. and 100 sacks neat bulk cement. Plug @ 2869'. Job started @ 12:30 p.m. and completed @ 7 p.m.

Propose to drill plug and test shut-off 7 p.m. August 10, 1948..
