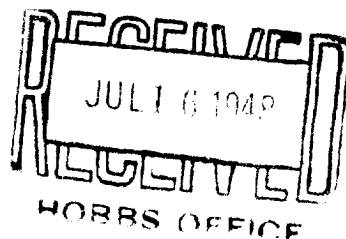

### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The hole was washed down and the casing tested with 1200# pressure applied for 30 minutes after partially drilling out cement from 9525' to 9536' which is 64' above csg. point. The test was OK, and after approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to perforate the csg. opposite the Simpson and complete the well.

Top of cement back of 7" csg. @ 5200' per temperature survey.
