Dear Bill:

Your letter of April 1, 1958 requested that your May Well No. 1-B in Section 21, T-23-S, R-37-E be reclassified as a gas well in the Langlie Mattix Oil Pool. Based upon your supporting evidence of the producing characteristics of this well I wish to advise you that effective May 1, 1958 this well will be classified as a gas well in the Langlie Mattix Oil Pool, and any fluids produced from this well will be considered incidental fluids produced from a gas well.

However I wish to advise you that the gas allowable shall be based on the formula $NSA \times 10,000$. If at some date in the future the characteristics of the well be such that a more proper definition would be an oil well, that classification is to be requested.
