On October 6, 1950, ran 9 joints 298' of 13 3/8" OD 48# Gr. H-40 SS casing. Set and cemented at 302' with 250 sacks bulk and 150 sacks of sacked cement. Job complete 11:55 p.m. on October 6, 1950. Cement did not circulate. Found top of cement back of 13 3/8" casing at 40', cemented with 100 sacks common sack cement through 2" pipe with Halliburton. Job completed 11:00 a.m. October 7, 1950

Propose to drill plug and test shut off 11:55 a.m. October 8, 1950.
