Gentlemen:

Receipt is acknowledged of "Notice of Intention to Drill" dated March 3, 1952 covering your well No. 1 Gambrell located on subject land in C S.  $\frac{1}{4}$  NW  $\frac{1}{4}$ , section 26, T. 23S, R. 37E, undesignated area, Lea County, New Mexico.

Your proposed work is approved subject to compliance with the provisions of the Oil and Gas Operating Regulations revised May 25, 1942, a copy of which will be furnished you on request, and subject to the following conditions:

1. Drilling operations so authorized are subject to attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
2. The 13 3/8" casing should be cemented with sufficient cement to reach the surface.
3. Cement behind the 8 5/8" casing should extend about 200 feet above the top of the Salado salt section, as determined by a temperature survey to be made within 12 hours after completion of the cement job.
