Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for permission to flare gas on your Melba Goins lease consisting of the E/2 SE/4 of Section 27, Township 23 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

In your application you have made reference to wells No. 1, 2-A and 3, however the request for permission to flare referred only to the Goins Well No. 2-A. Inasmuch as your request for exception referred mainly to the Goins Well No. 2-A, and inasmuch as there was insufficient information submitted to the other well drilling on said lease, the permission to flare will be granted, pending further investigation, to the Melba Goins Well No. 2-A only. Should it be your desire to secure permission to flare gas from your Goins Well No. 3, it will be necessary to submit another application.

Concerning the Melba Goins Well No. 1, due to its completion in the Teague-Devonian Pool it is not necessary to secure administrative approval to flare gas from this well.
