DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On 5-7-55 346.43' of 8-5/8" surface pipe was cemented with 250 sacks of Longhorn Portland cement of which a 150' cement plug was left in the bottom. On 5-14-55 a 12' cement plug was put in the top of the 8-5/8" surface pipe and a plate with a valve was welded on top of surface pipe.

NOTE: 8-5/8" surface pipe was found to be faulty and well was plugged and rig skidded 6 feet to the west and a new well started with the designation of Melba Goins #2-A in accordance with telephone conversation with Mr. Porter of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on 5-12-55.
