DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 91 joints 2875' of 8-5/8" 8 RT 28# H-40 SS casing. Set and cemented at 2899' w/1600 sacks 4% gel Longhorn cement and 100 sacks Neat on bottom. Plug at 2863'. Maximum pressure 1000#. Gulf temperature survey found top cement 490' below rotary table.

After waiting over 30 hours tested 8-5/8" casing w/1000# pressure for 30 min. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug from 2863' to 2899', tested cement below casing shoe w/800# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
