It is proposed to perforate the McKee zone from 9236-38'; 9276-78'; 9334-36'; 9360-62' & 9388-90', w/four JHPF, swab and test. Acidize w/500 gals. of 15% NE acid if swab test is not conclusive. If oil is available in commercial quantity, application for multiple completion will be submitted. If the McKee zone is not economical to produce, application will be made to use the McKee zone as a water injection well pending approval of Gulf's application to waterflood the subject lease's McKee formation.

Instructions
