Gentlemen:

The JOHN H. HILL La Manyon Federal "C" lease has two completed wells in the N/2 of the NE/4 of Section 27 Township 23 South Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Well #1 was completed on October 13th, 1959, and well #2 was completed on November 19, 1959, both as top allowable wells.

El Paso has the contract for this lease and is in the process of making a connection to it, and this should be completed within a short time. Since the 90 day flaring period on this lease has elapsed we are asking for an extension of this period in order to prevent the wells being shut in.

A plat is attached showing the location of the wells and the surrounding leases. El Paso has gas lines to the north and west.

Since every effort is being made to complete the connection on this lease, we shall appreciate any consideration you may give us on this application in order to prevent a costly loss of allowable, and possible damage to the wells.
