The TOM BROWN DRILLING COMPANY La Munion Federal lease has one well, completed in the SW/4 of the NW/4 of Section 28 Township 23 South Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, on February 23, 1960.

El Paso has all this casinghead gas on the La Munion lease under contract, and they are in the process of making a connection, which should be completed within a short time. Since the ninety day period for flaring has elapsed, we are requesting an extension of the time in order to prevent the well being shut in.

A plat is attached showing the location of the well and the surrounding leases. El Paso has gas lines to the north and west.
