Federal Lease, La Munyon

Dear Mr. Porter:

As agent in this case for E. Constantine, Jr., with office at cantile Bank Bldg., Dallas, Texas, I am applying for a order No. R-553 and requesting permission to flare gas on Federal lease, located in the E/2 of the NE/4 of Section 29, South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. There is a Munyon on the lease, located in Units A and H, and these are shown on 23 attached plats on which the lease is outlined in red.

El Paso Natural Gas Company has a gas line on the Gulf La Munyon about 1/4 mile from well No. 2, and plans to connect to the Com lease as soon as it is possible to do so. However, it may not be possible for them to make this connection before the "90 day" period the No. 1 well is up, which would be Feb. 20, 1958. We are asking permission to flare gas from these wells until such time as El Paso makes the connection.

The tank battery for the lease is located in Unit H of Section 29, and the wells are flaring approximately 218 MCF per day. The Gas Oil Ratio on the completion test for the No. 1 well was shown as 4960:1.

We shall appreciate your consideration in this matter. If further information is needed, please advise me.
