Federal Lease

Dear Mr. Porter:

As agent in this case for E. Constantin, Jr., with offices at 2807 Mercantile Bank Bldg., Dallas, Texas, I am applying for an exception to Order No. N-553 and requesting permission to flare gas on their La Munion Federal lease, located in the E/2 of the NE/4 of Section 29, Township 23 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. There are two wells on the lease, located in Units A and H, and these are shown on the attached plate on which the lease is outlined in red.

El Paso Natural Gas Company has a gas line on the Gulf La Munion lease about 1/4 mile from well No. 2, and plans to connect to the Constantin lease as soon as it is possible to do so. However, it may not be possible for them to make this connection before the "90 day" period on the No. 1 well is up, which would be Feb. 20, 1958. We are asking permission to flare gas from these wells until such time as El Paso makes the connection.

The tank battery for the lease is located in Unit H of Section 29, and the wells are flaring approximately 218 MCF per day. The Gas Oil Ratio on the completion test for the No. 1 well was shown as 4960:1.

We shall appreciate your consideration in this matter. If further information is needed, please advise me.
