Re: Application to Dually Complete Gulf Oil Corporation's C. E. LaMunyon No. 18, Langlie-Mattix Pool, Lea County, New Mexico

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Gentlemen:

By this letter of application, Gulf Cil Corporation wishes to state the following:

(a) That Gulf Oil Corporation's C. E. LaMunyon No. 18, located 660' FNL and 1980' FWL of Section 29-235-37E, was completed August 26, 1951 at a total depth of 3700'. The attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of this well on the Gulf Oil Corporation's C. E. LaMunyon Lease together with the location of all offset wells. The attached Exhibit "B" shows a diagrammatic sketch of the proposed dual completion.

(b) That subject well has 7" casing set at 3470' and cemented with 650 sacks of cement. The well is an oil well producing from the open hole interval from 3470-3700' in the Langlie-Mattix Pool.

(c) That the applicant porposes to dually complete the well in the following manner:

- 1. Perforate the 7" casing within the approximate interval of 2700-3300' in the Jalmat Gas Pool.
- 2. Set production type packer below these perforations at approximately 3400' to separate the two pay zones.
- 3. Produce the Langlie-Mattix Pool oil through the tubing and the Jalmat gas through the tubing-casing annulus.

(d) That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with gas from the Jalmat and oil from the Langlie-Mattix is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.

(e) That the applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.

(f) That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.
