On August 8, 1951 ran 113 joints, 3466', 7" OD 8 R.T. new SS casing with short T&C from bottom up as follows: 18 joints 20# J-55 R-2, 81 joints 20# H-40 R-2, 14 joints 23# J-55 R-1. Set at 3470'. Cemented 7" OD casing with 650 sacks 2% Gel bulk cement. Plug at 3442'. Cement circulated. One 7" Baker centralizer at 3465'. Job completed at 4:00 a.m., August 8, 1951.
