

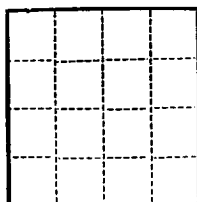

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

It is proposed to drill with Rotary Tools to the Seven Rivers-Queen formation at about 3,500'. Set 8-5/8" casing at 300' with cement circulated. If productive, set 5-1/2" casing to Total Depth and cement with about 250 sacks, which gives a calculated fillup of 1,691'.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
