## CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL:

- 1. The Hobbs office (telephone (505) 393-3612) is to be notified when workover operations are to be commenced.
- 2. Blowout prevention equipment is required.
- 3. Injection into this well is not to be commenced until the plugged well in the  $SW_4SW_4$  sec. 20, T. 23 S., R. 37 E. is re-entered and properly abandoned. Information concerning the manner in which the well is re-plugged and the date the work is done should be furnished this office.
- 4. An injection profile survey is required when fill-up is obtained and surface injection pressure becomes necessary. A copy of the survey, together with your analysis, must be furnished this office. All steps necessary to ensure that the injected water enters only the proposed injection interval must be timely taken.
- 5. The surface injection pressure at the wellhead is not to exceed 900 psi unless it can be established that a higher pressure will not result in fracturing of confining strata and such higher pressure is approved.
