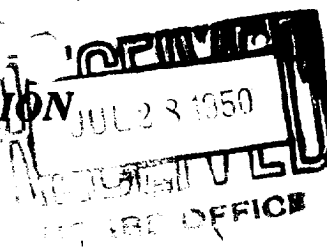

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Killed well with 9.9# Salt Water, pulled tubing (left loose in well after fire when completed) ran Lane-Wells Electric Log. Found TD to be 3004' instead of 2978' as reported. Set packer in bottom joint of 7" casing at 2958'. Pressured to 1000# between tubing and casing. Held 1000# for 30 min. without leaking. Swabbed in. Will run temperature survey as soon as well is back on normal production.
