Gentlemen:

By this letter of application, The Texas Company wishes to state the following:

- a. That the applicant has requested by letter of application, dated May 11, 1955, permission to dually complete its E. E. Blinebry "B" (NCT-1) Well No. 4. This well is located 660 feet from south line and 1980 feet from east line of Section 31, T-23S, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico.
- b. That the applicant proposes to assign this well a non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the entire lease or 315.96 acres which is the 3/2 of Section 31, T-23S, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico. That this is in accordance with Rule 5(a) of Order R-520 of Jalmat Gas Pool, which allows 320-acre units for such well locations in the Jalmat Gas Pool.
- c. That the entire proposed non-standard proration unit is wholly within the horizontal and vertical limits of the Jalmat Gas Pool as set out in Order R-520.
- d. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section, that it does not exceed 5280 feet in length or width and that it consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
- e. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas. That the Commission has previously approved non-standard proration units as shown on attached Exhibit "A" for offset wells as follows:


6. The Commission has received the application and is currently reviewing it. The Commission will notify the applicant of its decision as soon as possible.
