DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

June 6, 1939, shot with 100 qts of SNG in 3 1/2" shells from 3652' to 3512'.

Production before shot: Flowed 35 bbls oil in 24 hours.


Production after shot: Flowed 178 bbls oil in 24 hours with Gas-Oil ratio of 51,336 cu.ft.

Then set Exner-Dodge Hook-Wall packer at 3498', with 3' of perforations below, tubing set at 3501'. Well then flowed 180 bbls oil in 18 hours thru 1/2" choke wide open with 840,000 cu. ft. gas, GOR 3,500 cu. ft. per bbl. Corrected gravity of oil 32.8.
