Gentlemen:


W. K. Byrom respectfully requests administrative approval for the formation of a 160 acre non-standard gas proration unit. Our Davis No. 1 is an existing Queen Sand oilwell, located 1980' from the West line and 660' from the South line of Section 33-T23S-R37E, Lea County, New Mexico in Langlie Mattix (Jalmat) Pool. Our plans would be to dual complete this well in the Yates formation; and in support of this request states:

1. The proposed non-standard unit consists of the SW/4 of Section 33-T23S-R37E.
2. The unit consist of 160 acres wholly within a single section.
3. The unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
4. Copies of this application have been submitted to all operators as required under rule 104 (f).

In view of these facts, it is requested that the Commission enter an order approving the non-standard gas proration unit for W. K. Byrom Davis No. 1, as described above.
