On June 4, 1974 tubing was pulled and 25 drill cement retainer was set at 6,063 feet. Exposed bottom with 200 sacks cement and left 10 feet cement on top of retainer. Perforated casing with two 1/2" holes at 5,312, 5,326, 5,349, 5,489, 5,505, 5,522, 5,534, 5,584, 5,573, 5,583, 5,597, 5,614, 5,619, 5,653, 5,666, 5,696, 5,724, 5,731, 5,736, 5,753, 5,759, 5,770, 5,777, 5,783 and 5,789. Ran tubing and packer, spotted 500 gallons 15% regular acid at 5,800 feet, pulled up and set packer at 5,246 feet. Acidized well with 5,500 gallons 15% regular acid, using 104 ball sealers. Scrubbed and tested well. Pulled tubing and packer, fractured well with 60,000 gallons gelled water and 67,500 pounds 20/40 sand. Ran tubing, scrubbed well. Well kicked and flowed approximately 130 barrels fluid (mostly water) in 4 hours. Shut well in to disconnect from test tank and connect to battery. Work completed 6-8-1974.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
