Receipt is acknowledged of "Notice of Intention to Drill" dated August 13, 1952 covering your well No. 2-D Mill located on subject land in the SE 1/4, section 34, T. 23S, R. 37E, Tugue-Devonian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Your proposed work is approved subject to compliance with the provisions of the Oil and Gas Operating Regulations revised May 25, 1942, a copy of which will be furnished you on request, and subject to the following conditions:

1. Drilling operations so authorized are subject to the attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
2. Sufficient cement must be used behind the 13 3/8" casing to reach the surface.
3. Sufficient cement must be used in cementing the 9 5/8" casing to extend about 200 feet above the top of the Salado salt section, as determined by a temperature survey to be made within 12 hours after completion of the cement job.
