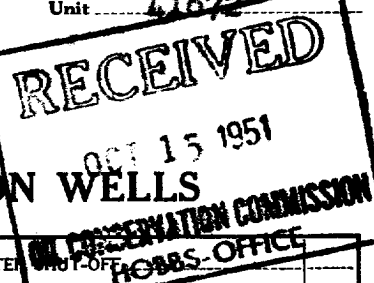

7" casing cemented at 3360' with 425 sacks.

With packer set at 3327, hydrafac open hole 3360-3544 with 1500 gals pumped in at 1040#. Max. pressure 2300#. Broke to 1700#. Final pressure 1700# on 10-7-51.

On 24 hour official Potential Test ending 10-9-51, well flowed 167 bbls pipe line oil thru 3/4" choke. Gravity 37.5. GOR 260.
