Receipt is acknowledged of "Notice of Intention to Drill" dated October 24, 1951 covering your Well No. 2 Blinebry (NCT-4) located in the C $NW_{4}^{1}SE_{4}^{1}$, section 35, T. 23S, R. 37E, Langlie-Mattix Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Your proposed work is approved subject to compliance with the provisions of the Oil and Gas Operating Regulations revised May 25, 1942 a copy of which has been furnished you, and subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Drilling operations so authorized are subject to attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
- 2. The 13 $3/8^{\circ}$ casing should be cemented with sufficient cement to reach the surface.
- 3. Cement behind the 7" casing should extend about 200 feet above the top of the Salado salt section, as determined by a temperature survey to be made within 12 hours after completion of the cement job.
- 4. Copies of sample log, electrical log, temperature and other surveys made are requested.
