Gentlemen:

By this letter of application Amerada Petroleum Corporation wishes to state the following:

- (A) That Amerada Petroleum Corporation Cagle "C" No. 1 is located 990 ft. from north and west lines of Section 3, Township 26 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. The well is located on a 480 acre lease being the E/2 and NW/4 of Section 3, Township 26 South, Range 37 East. The attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of this well together with the location of all offset wells.
- (B) That the subject well has 5½" casing set at 3314 ft. with 500 sacks of cement.
- (C) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the well in the following manner:
 - (1) Perforate the 5½" casing in the intervals 2680 ft. to 2735 ft.; 2748 ft. to 2830 ft.; 2838 ft. to 2860 ft., and 2885 ft. to 2940 ft. in the Yates and upper Seven Rivers, Jalmat Gas Pool.
 - (2) Perforate the 5½" casing in the intervals of 3165 ft. to 3195 ft. and 3230 ft. to 3250 ft. in the lower Seven Rivers and Queen, Langlie-Mattix Pool.
 - (3) Set production type packer at 2990 ft. to separate the two zones.
 - (4) Produce the Langlie-Mattix oil through the tubing and the Jalmat gas through the tubing-casing annulus. The attached Exhibit B is a diagrammatic sketch of the proposed dual completion.


