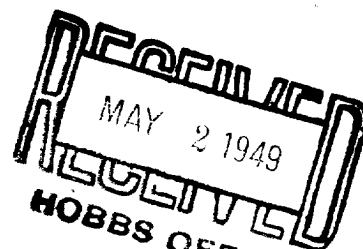

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3526' Total Depth, Dolomite. Ran Schlumberger E.S. & Their Gamma Ray. Ran Drill pipe open ended and spotted 65 Sx. Trinity Reg. cement from 3314' to 3526', spotted 15 sx. from 2478' to 2528', spotted 16 sx. from 1030' to 1080', spotted 16 sx. from 180' to 230'. Pulled drill pipe out & removed B.O.P. from 8-5/8" Csg. head. Ran cement plug from surface to 69' with 20 sacks Trinity Reg. cement & put 4" pipe 5' high in center of top plug. Finished at 1:00 A.M. 4-27-49. Well plugged and abandoned.
