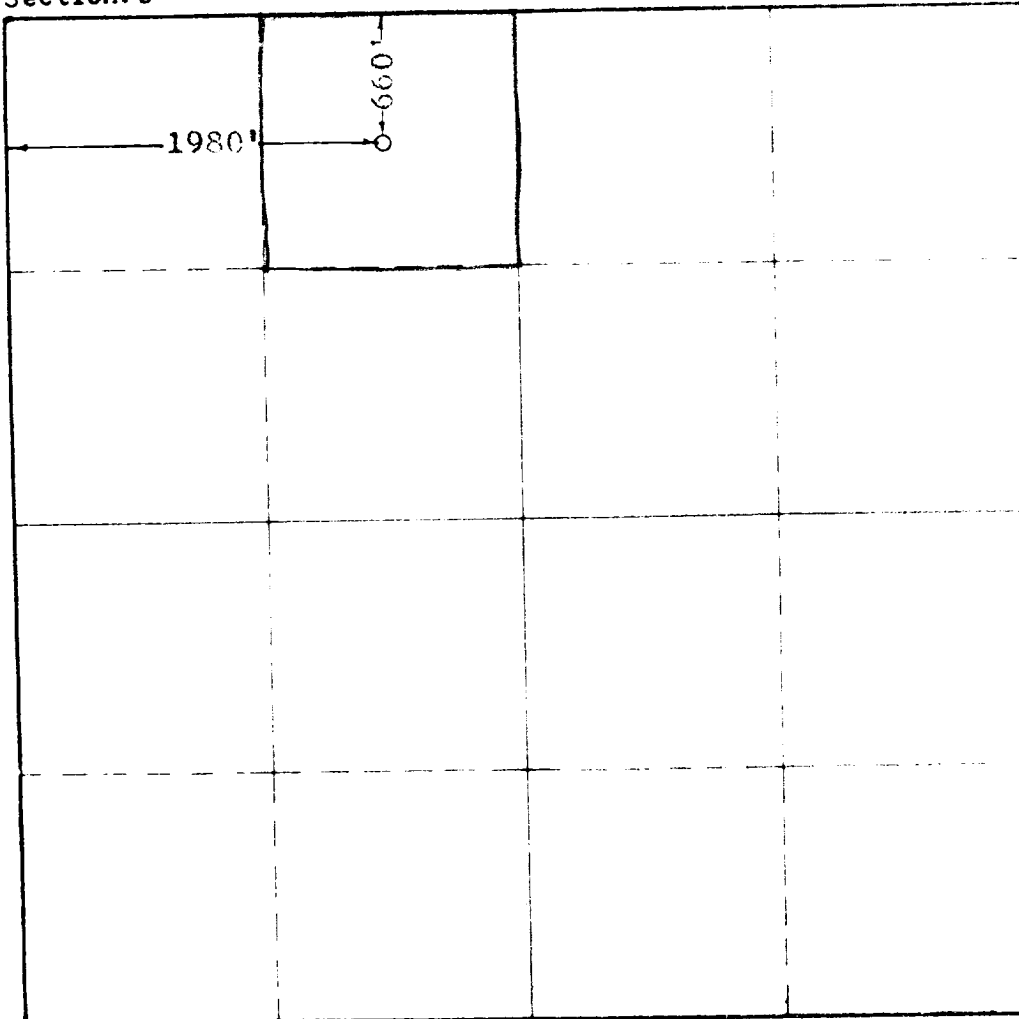


Gentlemen:

On December 4, 1958, a survey was made to locate your U.S.A. Farnsworth "C" No. 7 Well location at a point 660 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line of Section 4, Township 26 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

A flag was set at the U.S.G.L.O. Quarter corner marker common to Sections 4 and 33 and the Transit was set up at the U.S.G.L.O. Section corner marker common to Sections 32, 33, 5 and 4. Thence chaining East from Transit 1980 feet and thence South 660 feet to location site of the U.S.A. Farnsworth "C" No. 7. As a check on our survey we chained West from location site 1980 feet and North 660 feet to the beginning of the survey, checking in within the allowable error for this survey.
