DETAILS OF PLAN OF WORK

Well was treated with acid on May 21, 1934 as follows:
Hole was first filled with oil, using 129 barrels, then 1 barrel mud put in for blanket, then a solution of 1600 gallons of commercial hydrochloric acid heated to 180°, after which an oil load of 46 barrels was put in. Well shut in at 2:20 P.M. for acid to act, and remained shut in until 2:30 P.M. May 25, 1934, when well was opened.
