The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 2981 ft, approximately.

DETAILS OF PLAN OF WORK

We propose to drill this well as an offset to our Cagle No. 1 well located in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T-26-S, R-37-E, on lease Las Cruces 030176(a), Clifton C. Cagle original permittee. Well will be drilled entirely with rotary. The following horizons are expected at approximately the depths indicated:

Top of Rustler anhydrite - 995 feet,
Top of Main salt - 1145 feet
Top of Brown lime - 2800 feet
Top of White lime - 3025 feet
Top of Pay - 3359 feet.

We propose to use the following sizes and amounts of casing:

500 feet, 12-1/2 inch, 50#, second hand, cemented with 100 sacks.
2810 feet, 9 inch O.D. 34#, new, cemented with 500 sacks.
3288 feet, 7 inch O.D. 24#, new, cemented with 100 sacks.
