## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Under the Oil Conservation Commission's Case No. 55, Order No. 575, request is made by the Humble Oil & Refining Company for 99,100 barrels of Bonus discovery allowable for their Federal Leonard Oil Company Well No. 1 which discovered the top of oil and gas productive Ellenburger formation at a depth of 11,820 feet. Based upon the Conservation Commission's order, the bonus discovery allowable may be produced at a rate not to exceed 162 barrels per day. The request is made that this well be permitted to produce the full top unit allowable for Lee County plus such part of the 162 barrel bonus discovery allowable as will give it a flat production allowable of 200 barrels per day. It is further requested that this production allowable be granted until the well has produced the full 99,100 barrels of bonus discovery allowable.

Under date of October 30, 1944, the Conservation Commission was furnished a sample geological log. Attached hereto is an itemized production statement together with an ownership map of the area surrounding this well. We know of no producing well within a radius of 3 miles which is producing oil or gas from the Ellenburger formation.
