## DETAILS OF PLAN OF WORK

Ran 554'3" of 16" casing and cemented with 25 sacks of El Toro Oil well Special Cement using the bailer to place cement after cement was placed pipe was picked up to allow water to displace cement and let back down on bottom. Cemented top of casing and bottom of cellar with 15 sacks of cement. Let is set four days when hole was cleaned out and bailed out and hole was found to be dry. They are now drilling ahead.
