DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill a well at the above location with rotary tools to a depth of approximately 3300'. All casing strings will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U. S. Geological Survey.

It is planned to use the following casing pattern: 9 5/8" casing to be set at approximately 1160' and cemented with approximately 465 sacks. Cement to circulate to surface. 7" casing to be set at approximately 3300' and cemented with approximately 595 sacks, exact amount to be determined by Caliper and Temperature Surveys. 7" casing to be perforated opposite main pay zone.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
