FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

The Eaves A-19 No. 8 was completed at a plugged back depth of 3225' in the Seven Rivers formation on February 15, 1953. The Eaves A-19 lease is presently offset to the North, Northeast and Southwest by acreage allocated for Jalmat gas production.

We propose to Dual Complete this well in the Jalmat Oil & Gas pool by setting PKR at 3120', perforating the Yates formation intervals 2738-96', 2810-32', 2848-64', 2878-90' W/2 JSPF, set BP at 2900' and PKR above 2780', sandfrac Yates intervals W/12,000 gals of lease crude, 12,000 lbs sand and 1000 gals acid in 3 stages, take PKR leakage test and place well on production.
