I have examined the application dated 2/27/60
for the Continental Oil Co. Eaves A-19 #8-N 19-26-37
Operator Lease and Well No. S-T-R

and my recommendations are as follows:

Brown Boll Weevil pkr. is recommended for use only where one has a high
(lower fm.) differential pressure--1/5/60 B.H.P. run @ present perforations
@ 3154' = 1218 psig. In my opinion the gas zone will have a lesser B.H.P.
than the oil zone--E.F.E.

I do not recommend the approval of this well due to dual dedication of acreage.
This would constitute a dual well in one common geological reservoir--J.W.R.
